Dan Elves presented an Award of Recognition to Brett Lougheed in commendation of his leadership role and service to the Manitoba archival community by serving as committee chair, newsletter editor and the inaugural chair of the Technology Working Group thereby facilitating greater access to Manitoba's recorded heritage.

11. Other Business

Tom Nesmith announced the winners of the Association for Manitoba Archives Thesis of Distinction Award – Jordan Bass, Konrad Krahn, Madeline McLuhan-Myers and Dan Elves. Tom also announced that Jordan Bass won the Association for Canadian Archivists Gordon Dodds Prize for 2012, and that Konrad Krahn won the University of Manitoba William Gordon Dodds Award for Archival Studies in 2012 and the W.L. Morton Gold Medal. Mary Horodyski also won the Hugh A. Taylor Prize for Excellent in Archival Studies for 2011-2012.

Shelley Sweeney announced that the National Research Centre of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) will be housed at the University of Manitoba. Several job postings are or will be created for positions including director, archivist, and Canada Research Chair. Shelley encourages all AMA members to learn about the TRC and its work.

Tom Nesmith announced that the University of Manitoba/University of Winnipeg Joint Masters Program in Archival Studies is encouraging aboriginal students to enter the program. If AMA members know a suitable candidate they are encouraged to contact Tom Nesmith or Greg Bak or visit the Archival Studies website. Tom stressed how the TRC demonstrates the importance of archives and that the Archival Studies program is introducing more aboriginal content into its curriculum.

Korey Dyck announced that he has replaced Alf Redekopp as Director of the Mennonite Heritage Centre. Korey looks forward to meeting and collaborating with AMA members on archival projects.

Al Schmidt, archivist at the Altona & District Heritage Centre, announced that the IMAGES Exhibit is currently located in Altona. IMAGES is currently displayed in a shopping mall. Al rotates the images every week. IMAGES will stay in Altona until the end of December.

Jordan Bass announces that Andrea Martin will represent the AMA for the 2014 Manitoba Libraries Conference.

Martin Comeau called a meeting of the Board to take place following the AGM. He also thanked Conrad Stoesz and the Centre for Mennonite Brethren Studies for generously hosting the AGM.
